## **COURSE SUBSTITUTIONS**

Students may request a course substitution for a class that they feel can substitute for one of the Finance Certificate requirements. Requests must be made **prior** to taking a course. Course substitution requests will not be accepted after the completion of a course. Only courses with significant financial content will be approved.

Course substitution requests must be reviewed by the Finance Certificate Head for approval.

An example of this include but are not limited to:

• MIT (Sloan or non-Sloan) or Harvard courses not on the Finance Certificate course list that the student feels pertain to his/her career and academic interests in finance.
